



What about State Courts?

- This is where 98% of cases are filed
- 50M cases/year vs. < 400k in federal
- *Thousands* of state courthouses (mayoral, city, county, state appellate, supreme, etc.)
- Data access varies, can be expensive, difficult, non-existent





What is PACER?

- The Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER) service provides electronic public access to every federal court record.
- About 1.5B records the largest paywall on the planet.
- Access to case information costs \$0.10 per page, capped at \$3.00 for most documents.
- Criticisms: out of date, hard to use, expensive, anti-democratic, illegal.
- RECAP is a response that crowdsources documents and makes them freely available.
- Metadata about 350M documents, but only 10M docs.
- Full text searchable.
- Free



Finding a case on PACER

- DOJ announces before PACER has it or it's sealed
- 98 search engines:
 - Central search only updated once daily
 - District search is very bad
 - No full text
- Eventually has everything

Vs. on RECAP

- Very powerful search engine
 - Updated in real time
 - Full text
 - Case name search
 - Date ranges
- Built into RECAP extension
- Only has what is crowdsourced or scrapable



How can you get data out of PACER?

Alerts

- PACER users can keep track of newly docketed events by subscribing to a court's RSS feed, which is free and includes automatic notification of case activity, summarized text, and links to the document and docket report.
- Sign up for email alerts through some courts in pacer as a "Special Mailing Group"
- RECAP alerts for PACER

PACER Email Alerts

Sign up as a Special Mailing Group (SMG)

- Receive notices the same time as attorneys
- Charged to view/download filings but not for the alerts
- Requires registration (about a 24 hour delay)
- Have to register each court **separately**
- All appellate courts and *most* district courts

APIs & Webhooks

- An API is like a digital mediator that enables different software applications to talk to each other and exchange information. It defines the methods, parameters, and data formats you can use to access certain features or retrieve data from an application or service.
- A webhook can be thought of as a type of API that is driven by events rather than requests. Instead of one application making a request to another to receive a response, a webhook is a service that allows one program to send data to another as soon as a particular event takes place.





Enhancing the Data:

- Free Law Project developed <u>a parsing system</u> for the disclosures.
 - Takes the disclosure, whether it's a single-page TIFF, multi-page TIFF or PDF, scanned document or text, and converts it into machine-readable JSON data.
- A <u>machine learning model</u> to identify pages in the Senate hearing records that looked like financial disclosure documents.
 - Extracted 843 Financial Disclosure from over 250k pages of documents.
- Disclosures were converted into good PDF files and ingested the data into the database
- All data <u>available via CourtListener APIs and website</u>
- Connection of Financial Disclosures dataset with FLP's Judges database




